Code of Ethics

All BOMA Nashville members are expected to comply with the following Code of Ethics:

- Members shall treat each other with respect. All members recognize that the Association will be judged by the conduct of individual members.
- Members will treat use of membership information, membership resources, mailing lists, and contacts or working relationships professionally and ethically.
- Members shall use BOMA membership as a means of professional development for themselves and not for personal promotion.
- Members shall endeavor to provide educational and professional development information to the general membership.
- Members, both Principal and Allied, shall confine promoting their company's services to venues established for that purpose.
- Members shall not discriminate because of race, sex, creed, disability or national origin as it relates to their Association relationships.
- Members shall abide by the Constitution and Bylaws of the Association and shall support initiatives established by the Board of Directors.
- Members shall maintain compliance with these guidelines in all personal and professional dealings as representatives of BOMA Nashville. Membership revocation may result at the discretion of the BOMA Board of Directors in the event member(s) fails to comply.
